CALL FOR NOMINATIONS Council on Community Pediatrics 2010 National Pediatric Community Teaching Award

*****The deadline for submissions is 5:00pm (CT) on May 28, 2010.*****

Award Description

The Council on Community Pediatrics' **National Pediatrics Community Teaching Award** was designed to highlight the career of an individual community pediatrician who has dedicated a significant amount of time to the teaching of medical students and residents in their community setting. The award is co-sponsored by the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) and Academic Pediatric Association (APA). The National Pediatrics Community Teaching Award will be given to one member of the AAP each year. The award will be presented during the Council on Community Pediatrics Awards Luncheon at the annual AAP National Conference and Exhibition. Travel expenses will be reimbursed. The recipient will be asked to provide short remarks at the Council on Community Pediatrics Awards Luncheon.

Award Criteria

The Council on Community Pediatrics National Pediatrics Community Teaching Award recognizes pediatricians who provide significant education to medical students and residents in their community setting in order to improve the practice of pediatrics in the community. This award is designed for an individual whose main clinical and teaching activities have been outside of a traditional Academic Health Center but may work in collaboration or administratively with academic programs. The recipient will be chosen by the Council on Community Pediatrics Awards Committee through a competitive nominations process based on how well their nomination materials (see Nominations Process) illustrate that the nominee meets the criteria listed above.

Qualifications for Consideration

To be considered for this award, it is **required** that nominees are members of the American Academy of Pediatrics. Nominees are not required to be members of the Council on Community Pediatrics, but preference is given to Council members. Deceased persons are not eligible for awards. Members of the Awards Committee, Council on Community Pediatrics Executive Committee, and AAP Board of Directors are not eligible to receive this award during their term of service.

Nominations Process

If you know someone who merits recognition as a nominee for Council on Community Pediatrics National Pediatrics Community Teaching Award, please complete and submit the following:

- Nomination form (attached)
- A letter of nomination
- Curriculum vitae
- Documentation of teaching activities from sponsoring institution(s) including types of activities (teaching in private office, hospital office or clinic); type of trainee; approximate number of hours involved in teaching per year
- A letter of recommendation from either a Medical School Dean, Pediatric Department Chair, Residency Program Director, Medical School Clerkship Director or a Director of other Medical School Courses
- An 200 word essay about your interest/experiences in teaching
- A listing of any awards or innovative programs you have designed related to teaching in the ambulatory setting
