



Chapter Cheat Sheet Funding Opportunities

CATCH (www.aap.org/catch)

The CATCH Program offers funding opportunities to pediatricians and residents:

1. **Planning Grants**
 - Up to \$10,000 for planning activities that will lead to implementation of a project
 - Announced in May; Due at end of July
 - Contact Kathy Kocvara at x7632
2. **Implementation Grants**
 - Up to \$10,000 to implement a pilot project that will lead to a larger initiative
 - Announced in November; Due at end of January
 - Contact Holly Noteboom at x4916
3. **Resident Grants**
 - Up to \$3000 for planning and implementation activities
 - Grants available during both the above cycles
4. **Pilot Residency Training Grants** (<http://www.aap.org/commpeds/CPTI/Opportunities.htm>)
 - Joint CPTI & CATCH initiative
 - Up to \$10,000 for planning and implementation activities during 16-month period
 - Announced September 8; Due November 10

HEALTHY TOMORROWS (www.aap.org/commpeds/htpcp)

This program is a partnership between the federal Maternal and Child Health Bureau (MCHB) and the AAP. The MCHB provides funding and the AAP provided technical assistance to applicants and grantees.

- \$50,000 per year for 5 years
- Projects must be new, direct service health initiatives
- Call for proposals usually announced in July in the HRSA Preview (or check the Web site)
- Applications usually due in September or October

- Provides pediatric residency or medical programs up to \$4,500 to fund a 2 or 3-day educational program focusing on the field of community pediatrics or pediatric dentistry. Contact Lisa Brock at x4903.
